Pattayapat Field Cohort Ward is a temporary building built in the parking area of the Pattayapat Building, consisting of 6 ward buildings with medical equipment such as central monitors, patient monitors, High Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) filters, infusion pumps, continuous renal replacement therapy machines, and ultrasound machines. The Field Cohort Ward can accommodate patients up to 90 beds and can be adapted for a variety of applications,

from accommodating yellow-stage patients to converting them into a field intensive care unit if needed. This will help to reduce bed-waiting times and congestion in the emergency room. Currently, construction has been completed and is in operation.
